Student COVID-19 Screening Policy

Updated August 23, 2021

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that Orlando Ballet is providing a safe and healthy environment for its employees, students, and other guests at Harriett's Orlando Ballet Centre (HOBC).

Any employees, students, or guests who are experiencing illness, including COVID-19 symptoms, should stay home and away from the public environment and seek evaluation from their medical provider or a virtual visit healthcare service. Students should notify Orlando Ballet School Administrative Manager Jenny Logus (jlogus@orlandoballet.org or 407.418.9818) and Managing Director Katherine Fabian (kfabian@orlandoballet.org or 407.418.9811) as soon as possible if they develop symptoms or learn that they have been in contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19.

Screening Procedures

- All students (or their parents) will be required to complete a Self-Screening Affidavit attesting that they agree to complete a personal self-screening process each day prior to arriving at HOBC for class and/or rehearsal. Students have three options to complete this affidavit:
 - Sign and submit electronically online [HERE](#)
 - Log in to your ACTIVE account and sign the form online.
 - Print, sign and return via email or in person the form on page 2 of this document
- Any individual that self-identifies that they are currently exhibiting symptoms, have experienced symptoms within the last 14-days, have been exposed to anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19, or have recently traveled from certain areas should not enter HOBC and should contact Managing Director Katherine Fabian (kfabian@orlandoballet.org or 407.418.9811) as soon as possible.
- Students who exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 or signs of a temperature after initial entrance may be subsequently screened. An individual exhibiting any symptoms or who has a fever at or above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will be promptly isolated in a pre-designated isolation area. A symptomatic student's parents or guardians will be advised immediately, and they will be required to leave the building as soon as possible.
- Students who exhibit symptoms of COVID-19 should continue to isolate themselves and seek medical care.

Policy Updates and Enforcement

All policies and procedures are subject to change based on government and/or medical guidance. Any student or guests who is not compliant with the above policies, procedures, and protocols by any student or guest will be denied entrance to HOBC and/or will be asked to immediately leave HOBC. 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Student COVID-19 Self-Screening Affidavit

Effective Upon Execution

Coronavirus (COVID-19) has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. In response, Orlando Ballet has established health and safety policies and protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19 at HOBC. Orlando Ballet has also established screening procedures for employees, students, and guests, which must be followed each time an individual enters Harriett's Orlando Ballet Centre (HOBC).

By signing below, you understand, acknowledge, and agree that you (or your child) will complete a personal self-screening process each day prior to reporting to class or rehearsal at any Orlando Ballet facility or activity. This self-screening does not need to be recorded or registered in any way, but you should consider the following factors each day:

- I have not (or my child has not) tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10 days (10 days should be measured from the test date, not the date test results were received).
- I am not (or my child is not) currently experiencing any of the following symptoms nor have I (or my child) experienced any of the following symptoms in the past 48 hours:
 - Fever of 100 degrees or more
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Dry cough
 - Chills (sometimes with shaking)
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle pain or aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - GI symptoms like nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- I have not (or my child has not) had close contact in the past 10 days with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or is experiencing any of the above symptoms. Close contact is defined as being within 6 feet of an infected/ symptomatic person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period starting from 48 hours before illness onset (or for asymptomatic individuals, 48 hours prior to test specimen collection). NOTE: This does not apply to individuals who are fully vaccinated and do not need to quarantine after an exposure so long as they are not experiencing any symptoms. To be considered fully vaccinated, you must have received both doses of a 2-dose series or one dose of a single-dose vaccine at least two weeks ago.
