Orlando Ballet School is proud to incorporate the American Ballet Theatre National Training Curriculum, is a nine-level program that combines high-quality artistic training with the basics of dancer health and child development for students of all ages and skill levels. Orlando Ballet School is an ABT Certified School and a key partner in supporting ABT's education and training initiatives. ABT Certified Schools are not only committed to teaching ABT's National Training Curriculum in its ballet training program with faculty that is certified to teach the ABT Curriculum, but also present students annually for ABT Student Examinations along with hosting other ABT education & training events, performances & auditions.

WHAT ARE ABT NATIONAL TRAINING CURRICULUM STUDENT EXAMINATIONS?

The ABT National Training Curriculum Student Examinations are a graded examination system based on sound ballet principles, incorporating elements of the French, Italian & Russian schools of training.

WHAT OCCURS DURING ABT NATIONAL TRAINING CURRICULUM STUDENT EXAMINATIONS?

An adjudicator from the ABT National Training Curriculum Artistic Board of Examiners will observe the students perform a prepared examination class, which is conducted by the students' ABT Certified Teacher. The students must have the examination class memorized.

The Academy Preparatory program for Levels 2A/2B and 3A/3B provides accelerated training for students auditioned and accepted. This program is an add-on to the student's leveled classes. Classes within this program may require an early release from the student's mainstream school. If accepted, OBS will provide a letter to the student's principal as needed. Eligible students must be accepted into Levels 2A/2B or 3A/3B for the 23-24 dance season to be considered.

Academy Requires virtual or homeschool academic schedule

Orlando Ballet School's Academy Program is a full-day ballet training program for ages 12 through 18. There are three levels determined by age and ability. Dancers placed in Academy 1 train for 18-20 hours per week and students in Academies 2 and 3 train for 20-24 hours per week. Students complete their academics through virtual learning programs. In addition to classical ballet technique, dancers also study pointe, variations, modern, contemporary, and character.

Absences and Attendance

Rehearsals take place on Saturday afternoons and a detailed schedule will be made available after auditions. Students that must miss a Saturday rehearsal due to illness, an academic event such as an exam or testing, or a religious event such as a communion or observed religious holiday should email in advance all potential conflicts. Students who miss multiple rehearsals, whether excused absence or not will be re-evaluated on their ability to successfully perform their roles.

All rehearsals on October 29, 2022, and going forward including all rehearsals at the theatre are mandatory. Please note that there will be rehearsals before and during Thanksgiving Break that will be part of the mandatory rehearsal schedule. Any student missing a mandatory rehearsal will be withdrawn from the production.

CAMPS & JR. CAMPS

Jr. Summer and Spring Break Camps:

Our half-day Jr. Dance Camp at Harriett's Orlando Ballet Centre is designed for the young dancer (ages 3-5) and focuses on coordination, balance, rhythm, flexibility, and basic kinetic skills, as well as creative expression through dance. The classes are set to music and will introduce students to the foundational steps and vocabulary of ballet.

Summer and Spring Break Camps:

With both half-day and full-day options, the Dance Camp at Harriett's Orlando Ballet Centre is designed to provide our younger students continued intense ballet training, as well as expose them to other forms of dance such as jazz, character, and musical theatre. Level 2 students will also participate in pre-pointe classes.

Summer Camps:

Following the end of the second week, students will present a showcase performance for family and friends to attend. Please note that students must be registered for the full-day program for two weeks to be eligible for the summer camp showcase. Half-day campers are not eligible for the summer camp showcase performance.

OBS Classical Variation Expo is back! Students are eligible to participate. This program will allow participating students to perform a classical variation for a panel of ballet professionals from OB as well as an audience of family and friends on Sunday, January 30th, 2023, at our new Theatre at HOBC. All students will receive a written evaluation of their performance from the panel.

How does it work? Several variations will be selected by the faculty to be taught and worked on. The teachers will then select which variation participating students will perform.

Private Coaching: In addition, separate coaching will also be given by an Orlando ballet company member on Saturday, April 8, 2023. This will further prepare the students for their performance.

Costuming: Costuming for girls is the choice of leotard along with a matching skirt or practice tut (classical or romantic). Costuming for boys will be tights and t-shirt in appropriate colors. Costuming should be simple, and no new purchases are necessary. Costuming is the student/parent's responsibility and must be approved by department heads.

MASTER CLASS | JORDEN MORRIS

September 25, 2022

Orlando Ballet Artistic Director Jorden Morris.

Jorden Morris is an Alberta-born, internationally renowned ballet choreographer and director. He trained at the Banff Centre School of Fine Arts and Royal Winnipeg Ballet School. Morris began his career with the RWB after graduating and quickly rose to the rank of principal dancer, performing lead roles in both classical and contemporary works. After retiring from his career on stage. Morris studied



retiring from his career on stage, Morris studied choreography and theater arts at New York University, as well as early French choreography from Claude Bessy and Serge Golovine of the Paris Opera.

Morris then expanded his career by taking the position of Ballet Master and assistant to the Director at Boston Ballet. He rose to the rank of Chief Ballet Master and was the interim Director for the 2001 season. After returning to Canada as Associate School Director for the RWB, Jorden was commissioned to create his first full-length work, Peter Pan. This production became the biggest box office in the RWB's history until it was surpassed three years later by his next full-length ballet, Moulin Rouge® The Ballet. Jorden has also choreographed for the Genie and Gemini awards which were broadcast nationally and featured dancers from The National Ballet of Canada and the Royal Winnipeg Ballet.

Young Dancer Summer Session

Schedule and Class options:

Baby & Me (Must be between ages 18 Months-age 3 as of June 1, 2023) Introduce them to the magic of dance while enjoying the company of other parents and babies in our studio. This 45-minute class focuses on coordination, direction, balance, dance movement, and rhythm concepts that are great for the early development of kinetic skills. It will also introduce discipline while they learn to dance alongside other students. Designed for one dancer and one parent or designated guardian, this class is perfect for moms, dads, and another immediate family for exercise and bonding with their little ones.

2.5-3-year-old Ballet (Must be 2.5 as of June 1, 2023)

A fun class for 2.5-year-old children without parent participation. Since children naturally respond to music and movement, the activities are presented through music. This 45-minute class consists of movement activities meant to develop coordination, direction, balance, and rhythm through fantasy and the utilization of colorful props. It is the perfect preparation for school year programming as it introduces some very basic ballet vocabulary in a creative setting for your child's imagination. 

Fusion: Traditional Western Indian Dance + Bollywood with Ekta Desai

Indian dance has always been a part of my upbringing as an Indian American – many of our holidays and family milestones included traditional Gujurati dancing as a part of the ceremony or celebration (ie. Diwali). This became foundational to my involvement in multi-cultural events, dance competitions, and clubs throughout high school



and college. I led a co-ed Indian dance team at the University of Florida with (2) co-leads during my second year of undergraduate school and performed in state college competitions throughout both high school and college. My exposure and access to various cultural dance forms were limited while growing up in Jacksonville, FL. I've always been passionate about all kinds of dance, dance methodologies, etc., and with the diversity that exists in Orlando, I am thrilled to see that cultural dance education is so readily accessible at OB. Seeing the fusion of all forms of dance art in professional performances (i.e.. Jungle Book) is also especially meaningful and inspiring to me – it showcases that we truly are a collaborative, diverse art community that has unlimited opportunities to create.

This class will include a hybrid sequence of traditional garba and raas dance techniques from the western Indian state of Gujurat with a fusion of Bollywood influence.

SCHOLARSHIP | FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

Orlando Ballet School offers scholarships and financial aid to families based on merit and need to students in levels 2B and above. Scholarships are offered at the sole discretion of artistic directors and senior artistic staff and require the evaluation of financial information for all applicants.

All scholarship information is due on August 10, 2022.

OBS offers scholarships for eligible students:

- Potential candidates must be Orlando Ballet School students for at least one full consistent school year to be considered.
- They must be placed in Level 2B (in the current school year) and up. Family
 financial information is required to be submitted, including candidates for the
 STEPS and BRIDGE programs.

The following documentation is required for all scholarship applicants:

- Headshot of Dancer (not professional, no selfies)
- 250-word Essay/Bio. Written in the student's own words (parents may assist).
 Includes hometown, past dance experience, aspiration as a future dancer, how the scholarship will benefit your dancer, and what participation in our programs has meant to your student.
- A required financial application submitted through FACTS. Application is submitted online HERE (\$35 fee).

Incomplete applications or applications without required financial information will not be accepted or eligible for scholarships. This is regardless of whether solely merit-based or based upon combined merit and financial need.
